Eligibility

1. Current union member of a union participating in any Union Plus program. **Member does not have to purchase any Union Plus products or participate in any Union Plus program to apply.**
2. Applied toward the completion of an accredited degree, coursework or seminar at an accredited educational institution (college, university, community college, recognized technical or trade school). Note: Verification of acceptance/attendance at an accredited institution may be required prior to award being sent.
3. Awards must be used within 12 months of the award date.
4. Applicant must be female and/or a member of a racial/ethnic minority, defined as American Indian or Alaskan, Asian or Pacific Islander, African American, Hispanic, or Multi-racial.
5. Applications must be **postmarked** by **September 29, 2007** in order to be considered.

- ◆ Applicants wishing to receive confirmation of receipt of their applications may send a self-addressed, **stamped postcard** along with the application.
- ◆ Union Privilege **will not** be able to advise applicants as to the status of their applications.
- ◆ **Only WINNERS will be sent notification on November 7, 2007.**

Awards: Amounts range from \$500 to \$3,000. In addition, scholarship winners will be matched with current union leaders to participate in a special mentoring program.

Application Instructions

1. Application must be filled out by the applicant. Please type or print clearly.
2. All requirements must be met and all information must be completed in order for the application to be considered.
3. Enclose with your application **one letter of reference sealed in a separate envelope** from a union leader who is familiar with your achievements and abilities. Instruct your reference to sign his/her name across the seal of the envelope.
Applications without sealed letters of reference will not be considered; do not send letter of reference separately.
4. Attach an essay of about 500 words describing how this award will assist you in achieving your career goals and developing your leadership skills. **Applications without essays will not be considered; do not send essays separately.**
5. Review and complete the application checklist and sign the certification on the last page of this application.
6. Retain a copy of the completed application for your files.

In your essay describe your relationship with unions and the labor movement, and how it has personally affected your life. Highlight any challenges you have encountered as a woman and/or person of color. Keep in mind the focus of this scholarship award program—to assist in the development of diversified union leadership, a leadership which reflects the current and future membership of organized labor.

Letter of Reference

Please include one sealed recommendation letter from a union leader who is familiar with your achievements and abilities and can speak to your leadership potential. Instruct your reference to sign his/her name across the seal of the envelope. Also instruct your reference to include his/her contact information (address/phone #). **Applications without sealed letters of reference will not be considered.**

- ▶ **Only scholarship recipients will be notified.** A list of scholarship recipients will also be provided to international unions. All notifications will be sent on **November 7, 2007**, and any recipients not heard from in 30 days will be contacted by telephone.
- ▶ Applications **must** be signed in order to be considered.
